CANADIAN INDIAN CANOE.

The Indian canoe is made from the bark of the Birch, Spruce Fir or Elm, covering a light framework of cedar. Alternatively the hide of the Moose covers the frame, but this is not so light and portable. The Birch bark or hide is sewn on with the tough roots of spruce, while the gum from the spruce is used to seal the seams and make the craft watertight.
