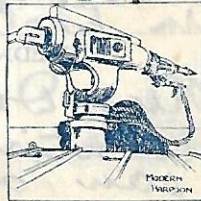

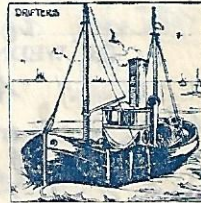

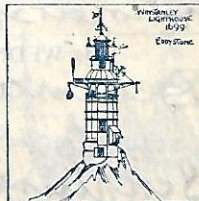

LIGHTHOUSES. Trinity Guild was
formed about the 12th century "to
provide navigation marks to help poor
mariners." The first Lighthouse was
built in the Scilly Isles in 1680. There
are four different types—the Bishops
Rock Lighthouse in the Scillys, built on
rock, those built on a steel cylinder sunk
into sand and filled with concrete, or
Lighthouses raised on piles driven into
the sea bed, and those built on a cliff
like the Lizard.

LIGHTSHIPS. Lightships mark the position of dangerous sandbanks and other obstructions. They are anchored and some, like the Humber Light are unattended; others, like the East Goodwin, are small ships in themselves. The lighting is as in the Lighthouse arranged in group flashes by a revolving light, or a fixed and steady light. Fog Horns and Whistles are fitted to Lightships as also to Lighthouses.
